Dear Mr. Sedell:

I received the letter from Paul Miller, City Mayor, dated October 21, 2009, in which Mr. Miller on behalf of the City of Simi Valley requested an additional 45 days to review the DEIR for the SVLRC Expansion Project. In the letter Mr. Miller explained that the purpose of the extension request is to allow the residents, the City Council and the surrounding community the opportunity to fully consider, and prepare comments on, the DEIR for the County's consideration.

Your request is consistent with the State CEQA Guidelines [California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, §15100(a), §15100(b), and §15105(a)]. Therefore, I have granted the City's request for a 45-day time extension to the public review period for the DEIR; the public review period will end on December 28, 2009.

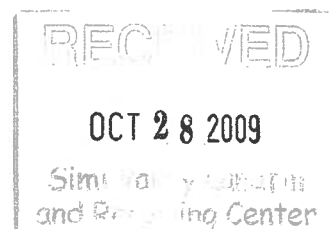
